Workshops for 6 to 9 year olds:

Repurposed Plastic

Time: 11 am - 12:15 pm

Create a sculpture using the work of Chakaia Booker as inspiration. While Chakaia uses rubber tires, students will use plastic bottles and push the material to its fullest extent by cutting, gluing, tying and folding.

A Sculptor's Model

Time: 1 pm - 2:15 pm

In conjunction with the Spring/Summer 2010 Exhibition Season, young artists will be introduced to Keith Haring's work in the galleries, with an emphasis on his large scale steel sculptures. They will return to the classroom to design and construct scaled down models of imaginary, mythic sculptures. Instructor: Margareta Warlick.

Cast-offs Recreated

Create a sculptural relief using repurposed and re-used materials and create a repeated pattern using simple materials such as tire tubes, rubber pieces, metal mesh, and "findings" in the style of Chakaia Booker. Instructor: Margareta Warlick.
