What is Night Forms?

Night Forms is a captivating, nighttime light and sound experience designed to engage with GFS' art and horticultural collection.

This is a special ticketed event and is not included in general daytime admission. Please arrive at the entry time window on your tickets. Early or late arrivals may not be admitted. In case of inclement weather forcing a closure, all ticketholders will be notified and refunded.

Please note: Member Guest Passes are not valid for this event.

Can we bring a group to Night Forms?

Groups of 15+ receive a discount; see below. <u>Click here</u> to book your group visit.

Adult 18+: \$28 (\$2 discount)

Student 6-17: \$22 (\$2 discount)

Member Adult: \$20*

Member Youth: \$16*

*Members do not receive an additional discount on group sales.

I want to visit Grounds For Sculpture during the day and stay for Night Forms. Can I do that?

Night Forms tickets are separate from daytime General Admission tickets. Please note that Grounds For Sculpture will close between daytime hours and *Night Forms*.

How much is parking and where do I park?

Parking is free and is located around the Seward Johnson Center for the Arts, which is the large building you'll see when you enter through the front gates.

I'm interested in visiting *Night Forms*, but I don't have a car. How do I get to Grounds For Sculpture?

There are two train stations nearby in Trenton, NJ and Hamilton, NJ. From there, request an Uber or Lyft to 80 Sculptors Way, Hamilton, NJ.

This takes place at night. Can I bring a flashlight?



Night Forms is a mostly outdoor experience, and some areas may be dark. Bring a flashlight if you'd like.

How long is the experience?

Most visits are about 1-2 hours long. There will be warming areas and beverages and treats for sale so stay as long as you like!

How should I dress for the experience?

Please wear appropriate clothing and footwear for the current weather conditions in our area from November – April. Flat shoes are recommended as our routes alternate between gravel, pavers and grass.

Is photography allowed?

Feel free to take personal photos and videos. No drones are allowed. Professional photography/videography requires advanced approval.

Can I bring my pet?

Pets are not allowed at Grounds For Sculpture. Service animals are always welcome.

Is this experience accessible?

The majority of the experience takes place outdoors on our Main Loop which is fully accessible. ECVs and wheelchairs are available to rent in the Welcome Center on a first come, first served basis. Rental fees for ECVs are \$25/4 hours and wheelchairs are \$15.

Night Forms is a multi-sensory experience with light projections and sounds. If you find yourself overloaded by the additional stimuli, please see staff for immediate assistance. This exhibit may potentially trigger seizures for people with photosensitive epilepsy. Viewer discretion is advised.

What are my dining options during Night Forms?

<u>Van Gogh Café</u> is open from 5PM – 9:30PM in the Seward Johnson Center for the Arts, the Gazebo offers hot drinks and snacks on the *Night Forms* route, and <u>Rat's Restaurant</u> is open as well. Reservations are highly recommended for dining at Rat's: make your <u>reservation online</u>
