

TEAM BUILDING AT GROUNDS FOR SCULPTURE

Activities are designed for a fun and relaxing creative experience and can be customized to support your meeting goals and themes. All workshops are 90 minutes in length. The rate is \$35 per participant.



When faced with finding tough solutions, we are often told to "think outside the box." What if all you have to work with is what's *inside* the box? Sharp thinking and breakthrough ideas are honed in this studio workshop. Teams collaborate on a themed sculpture using limited time, materials, and resources – with a twist – in a way that empowers innovation.



What moves and motivates your team? Gain insight as we transform everyday objects into dynamic one-of-a-kind team sculptures. Each participant brings one item from work or home that represents something of significance to their life or project viewpoint. The objects are then combined with themes that reflect common threads among the team.



How does one piece of the big picture contribute to the greater whole? In this relaxed group painting workshop, each participant receives one portion of a larger image to paint onto a canvas using their choice of style and color. The finished canvases are then assembled together to reveal the collective artwork made by the group. This activity demonstrates how connections are made and individual perceptions can be seen in new ways.



Perspective is an important part of how we experience the world around us and each other. This team workshop builds skills for observing, analyzing, questioning, and assessing as a group. Teams participate in a creative outdoor challenge that involves swift critical thinking, dialogue, and decision-making.



Clay is one of the oldest known materials for creative expression. As we push and pull the clay into shape, we enter into a dialogue with ourselves and each other and form a visual language of our collective ideas. Focus is on hand-building techniques using air-dry clay. Adaptable to all skill levels – beginner to expert.



In this fast-paced outdoor challenge, teams race against the clock using visual hints to find specific sculptures and earn points. A fun way to relax and see the grounds. Prizes are awarded to the winning team.

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With 42 acres and approximately 350 works of art, a guided tour provides a deeper look into the sculptural secrets and rich history of Grounds For Sculpture. Tours are one hour in length and each guide can accommodate about 15 people. Multiple guides can be arranged for larger groups. Fee is \$100 per guide and includes admission to GFS.

This special package rate is only available with the purchase of another Team Building workshop.



In this workshop, learn to tackle stress in the workplace using wellness techniques, including relaxed breathing exercises, Qigong forms, and Tai Chi. This movement-based program is offered by Dao Concepts, a veteran-owned organization that helps individuals live a life in balance.

Please note that this program is facilitated by a contracted instructor and requires a minimum of six weeks advance notice to book.

WORKSHOP BOOKING INFORMATION

- All fees include admission to GFS, so you can wander at leisure on the day of your visit.
- Arrange one or more workshops to customize a more immersive experience.
- Please book all reservations as far in advance as possible to ensure your date is available. We require notice of at least two weeks for bookings.
- Workshops are designed for groups of 10 to 300+ participants. Group size minimum is 10 participants – smaller group sizes are welcome but will require a base fee of 10 participants (\$350) for any workshop.
- Final participant count is due two weeks before your booked reservation date.
- A non-refundable deposit of \$350 is due at time of booking.
- GFS has ample, free parking on site.
- Gates open at 10AM workshops are conducted during GFS operational hours; please note that times and days vary by season.
- All dining and catering arrangements must be handled directly with our partner Constellation Culinary Group. No outside food or beverages are permitted on our campus. To accommodate groups of 50 people or more, the GFS Events department will assess a Capacity Fee. The fee is a flat rate of \$500 to provide for the increase in additional staff, gallery or tent usage, seating, staging, microphones or other A/V and additional staff and supplies. For a group of 50, this amounts to an additional \$10 person; for a group of 100 people, this amounts to an additional \$5 per person. The fee will be billed separately by the Events department.
