



# GRADES 3-5 HANDS ON WORKSHOPS

## CLAY CREATIONS

“Think like a sculptor” and make a work of art in clay inspired by imagination and creativity. Students will discover the expressive qualities of clay by learning a variety of sculpture building techniques. They will then discuss their artistic choices with their peers. Through guided looking and the exploration of clay building techniques, students will learn to appreciate the work of other artists.

## SCULPTURES IN MOTION

Explore Seward Johnson's popular sculptures of ordinary people doing everyday things. Then, it's time for students to strike a pose. These poses will be used to develop an artistic 3D form that captures students' moments in motion. This session includes touring sculptures in the J. Seward Johnson Gallery and outside on the grounds.

## MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS

Grounds For Sculpture is a collaborative space where many works of art are gathered to create a visual symphony of texture, shape, size, and movement. Students will learn the power of teamwork by creating instruments with a variety of natural materials and found objects. The session concludes with the instruments being used in a class performance, showcasing the power of collaboration.

**1hr | Additional \$8 per student | 20 students max per session**

## CREATE A CREATURE

Can you design a new creature? In this workshop, students will go on a guided tour to see how artists make creatures in sculptural form. Participants will then return to one of our classrooms to create their own creature inspired by words and imagination.
