



GRADES 6-12 HANDS ON WORKSHOPS

CLAY CREATIONS

“Think like a sculptor” and make a work of art in clay inspired by imagination and creativity. Students will discover the expressive qualities of clay by learning a variety of sculpture building techniques. They will then discuss their artistic choices with their peers. Through guided looking and the exploration of clay building techniques, students will learn to appreciate the work of other artists.

1hr | Additional \$8 per student | 20 students max per session

EMO-WATERCOLOR

In "Emotional Watercolor," students will create a visual representation of an emotion through watercolor, using music and sound as a starting point. They will learn about the concepts of abstraction and non-objective art and will then apply those concepts to their observations and interpretations of artwork found throughout the sculpture park. This session includes guided explorations outdoors on our campus.

1hr 45 min | Additional \$10 per student | 20 students max per session

WIRE SCULPTURES

Explore how artists can use metal lines to create a variety of forms and participate in a STEAM-based design thinking challenge. Students will be introduced to working with and shaping metal wire to create their own piece to take home. Participants will learn safety precautions and the properties of metal as a working material.

1hr | Additional \$10 per student | 20 students max per session

SHADOW SCULPTURE: GET SHADY

Discover how sculptures cast their own shadows live! Then venture into our Education Studio to create a 3-D form of your sculpture and its shadows. This session includes guided explorations outdoors in the sculpture park.

1hr 45 min | Additional \$10 per student | 20 students max per session

SELFIE SCULPTURE CHALLENGE

Get ready to explore GFS in a new way—by putting yourself in the picture! Working in teams or pairs, find a series of items and take a selfie with each one during this timed activity. Take as many selfies with the listed items as you can, as fast as you can, and your team will win a prize! For this activity, students are required to bring a device with picture-taking capabilities, such as a smartphone.
